

Saranya won 2nd place in the "Prana" competition conducted by ICPS, Women and Child Development Dept. as part of "Sargavasantham- 2021"


Arya S, Child Welfare Officer at ATMA Gurukulam attended a resource organization meeting organized by Childline.

The CHG meeting was held on 24th March at the VIP lounge, Thrissur Railway station.








ATMA RESEARCH AND DEVELOPMENT CENTRE
