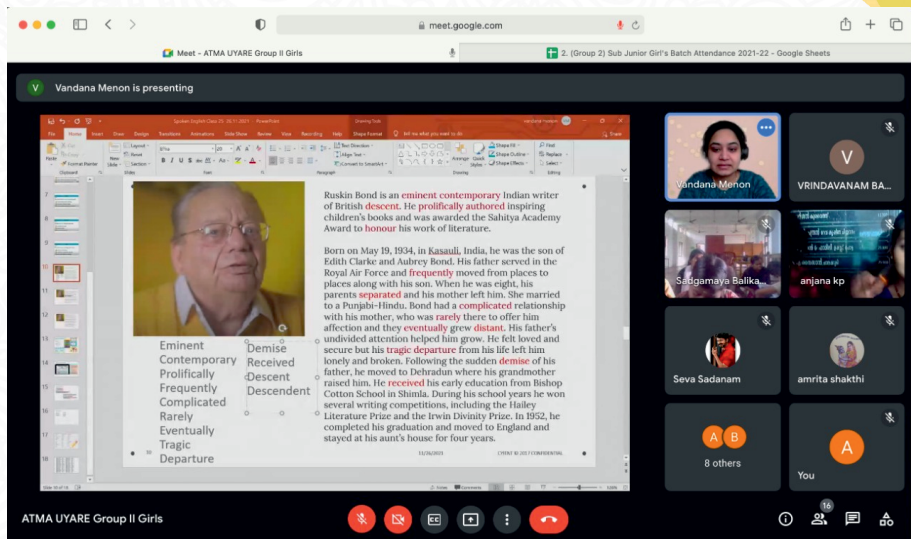




## ATMA YOGA PEETHOM
